# SALVATION

## What Is It?

If there is anything greatly wonderful and highly important man could ever have in this world,...  
IT IS HIS SALVATION!

### I. WHAT IS SALVATION?

#### 1. It is God's plan of redemption for sinners through our Lord Jesus Christ.

<sup>4</sup> *"For he chose us in him before the creation of the world to be holy and blameless in his sight. In love <sup>5</sup>he predestined us for adoption to sonship through Jesus Christ, in accordance with his pleasure and will—" Ephesians 1:4-5*

The Bible says, man was created in the image and likeness of God.

<sup>26</sup> *"Then God said, "Let us make mankind in our image, in our likeness, so that they may rule over the fish in the sea and the birds in the sky, over the livestock and all the wild animals, and over all the creatures that move along the ground. <sup>27</sup> So God created mankind in his own image, in the image of God he created them; male and female he created them."* **Genesis 1:26-27**

The very life of God was in him.

<sup>7</sup> *"Then the LORD God formed a man from the dust of the ground and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life, and the man became a living being." **Genesis 2:7***

Man has three compositions: *spirit, soul, and body*. The *body* is the visible composition of man, which is formed out of the dust from the ground. The *spirit* is the invisible composition of man, which is created from the breath of God. And the *soul* is the product of the *body*, which is formed from the dust of the ground and the *spirit*, which is created in the image and likeness of God Himself. In these three, the *spirit* is the leader; the *soul* is the servant; and the *body* is the slave. The *spirit* carries the very image, the very nature, and attributes of God manifests as holiness, righteousness, peace, joy, authority, power, dominion, wisdom, and freedom. The sole duty of the *spirit* is to keep a constant unity and intimacy with God. The duty of the *soul* is to make his own will, mind, and emotion. While the *body* is a slave of who is stronger between the *spirit* and the *soul*.

When man has committed "sin", his *spirit* died. Man is then consisted of only two compositions: *body* and *soul*. During this condition of man, the *soul* dominates over his *body*. What the *soul* desires to do is what the *body* is enslaved to do also. The whole nature of man becomes sinful. Not only his *spirit* died because of sin, but his relationship with God is also broken. He is separated from God. Thus, no matter how he strives to call God the Father through prayers, nothing happens.

<sup>2</sup> *"But your iniquities have separated you from your God; your sins have hidden his face from you, so that he will not hear."* **Isaiah 59:2**

No matter what he does to draw near to God the Father even through education, worthless religion, self-flagellation, or good deeds, everything is useless. This is all because his access to God is broken. Sin has destroyed the bridge between man and God and the bridge to hell is built. And man is going to eternal death into the fires of hell.

<sup>8</sup> *"But the cowardly, the unbelieving, the vile, the murderers, the sexually immoral, those who practice magic arts, the idolaters and all liars—they will be consigned to the fiery lake of burning sulfur. This is the second death."* **Revelation 21:8**

Thus, God the Father sent Jesus to save and to reconcile humanity back to Him.

The moment man is reconciled with God through Jesus Christ, who is his redemption, his sinful nature is cleansed. And it is transformed into the very nature of God which is holy, righteous, pure, and perfect.

<sup>17</sup> *"Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here!"* 2 Corinthians 5:17

As a result, the bridge between man and God is restored and the bridge that leads to hell is destroyed! This is God's divine plan for man.

## **2. It is the love of God to His creation through our Lord Jesus Christ.**

All have sinned.

## **4. It is freedom from the curse of sins, sicknesses, diseases, poverty, death, and all the works of the devil.**

## **5. It is God's abundant grace for the lost.**

## **6. It is restoration of our true nature, which was created according to God's image and likeness - from sinful nature back to the very nature of God in us.**

The nature of God in man which was lost and ruined by sins has been restored through the redemptive work of our Lord Jesus Christ on the cross.

The nature of God in us is not just restored, but rather it is more glorious than before!

## **7. It is our privilege to live like our Lord Jesus Christ.**
