Isaiah 11: 2

And the Spirit of the Lord shall rest upon Him, the Spirit of wisdom and understanding, the Spirit of counsel and might, the Spirit of Knowledge and of the fear of the lord.

The above Scripture talks about the **Seven Spirits of God**. They are:

1. The Spirit of the Lord
2. The Spirit of Wisdom
3. The Spirit of Understanding
4. The Spirit of Counsel
5. The Spirit of Might
6. The Spirit of Knowledge
7. The Spirit of the Fear of the Lord.



The Rainbow is the Seven Spirits of God.



The Lamp of God is the Seven Spirits of God

Forms of the Holy Spirit.

In the Bible there are seven symbols of the Holy Spirit. They are as follows:

1. Water

John 7:38 – 39

38 He who believes in Me, as the Scripture has said, out of his heart will flow rivers of living water.”

From the above Scripture we can understand that Rivers of living water (Holy Spirit) will flow out from a person who believes in the Lord Jesus Christ.



2. Fire

Ezekiel 8: 2

2. Then I looked, and there was a likeness, like the appearance of fire- from the appearance of His waist and downward, fire; and from His waist and upward, like the appearance of brightness, like the color of amber.

Ezekiel saw God as a Spirit which appeared to him as a burning fire. And the Spirit lifted him up with a hand and placed him between the earth and the heaven and made him see visions.

3. Rain

Hosea 6: 3

3. Let us know, Let us pursue the knowledge of the lord. His going forth is established as the morning; He will come to us like the rain, like the latter and former rain to the earth.

God will pour out His Spirit on us in these last days like the rain.





4. Oil

Psalm 92: 10

10. But my horn You have exalted like a wild ox; I have been anointed with fresh oil.

The anointing of the Lord was poured up on King David like an oil.



5. Dove

Luke 3:22

22. And the Holy Spirit descended in bodily form like a dove upon Him, and a voice came from heaven which said, "You are My beloved Son; in You I am well pleased."

The Holy Spirit descended upon Lord Jesus in bodily form like a dove, when He came out of the water after being baptized.



6. Wind

Acts 2:2

2. And suddenly there came a sound from heaven, as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled the whole house where they were sitting.

The Holy Spirit descended upon the apostles of the Lord Jesus Christ like a mighty rushing wind when they were waiting in the upper room of a house.



7. Cloud

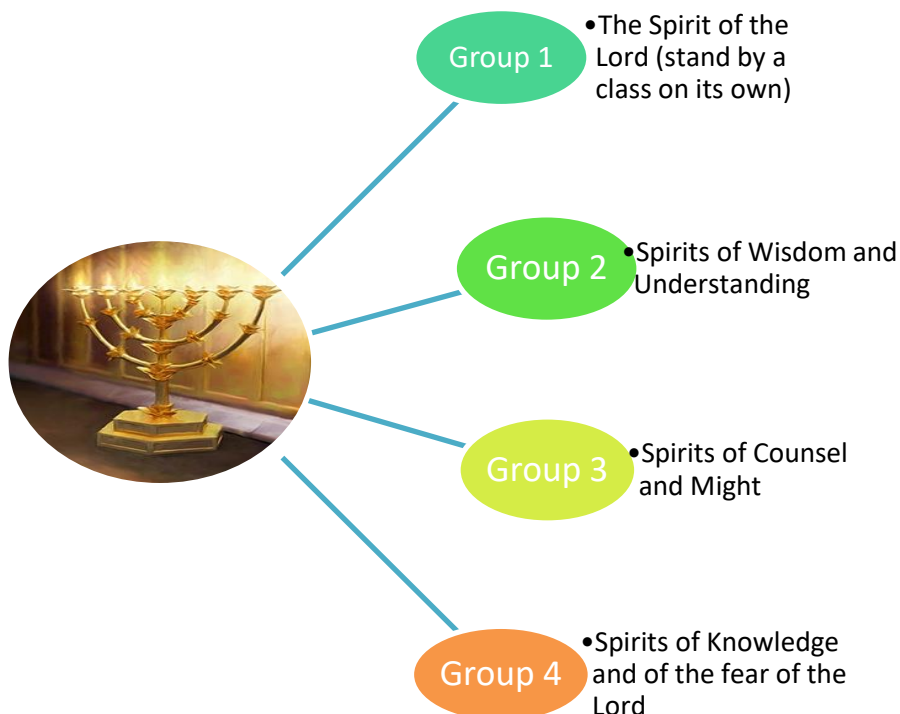
Exodus 33: 8

8. And it came to pass, when Moses entered the tabernacle, that the pillar of cloud descended and stood at the door of the tabernacle and the Lord talked with Moses.

God spoke to Moses from the clouds.

The **Seven Spirits of God** work together in **four groups**.

2. THE SPIRIT OF WISDOM AND REVELATION

Isaiah 11:2

2 “And the Spirit of the Lord shall rest upon Him, the Spirit of wisdom and understanding, the Spirit of counsel and might, the Spirit of knowledge and the fear of the Lord.”

Here we read about the Spirit of Wisdom and Understanding.

Definition of the Spirit of Wisdom

The Spirit of wisdom is the ***supernatural ability*** of God that comes up on our spirits to



- ❖ to see the Lord Jesus as He is
- ❖ get a spiritual understanding and knowledge of the Word of God

1. It ***helps us*** to

- ❖ know what to do, when to do, and how to do in every situation
- ❖ increase our God given talents to fulfill His plans and purposes

2. It ***shows us*** the

- ❖ unsearchable wisdom
- ❖ secrets of Godthings of heaven

In short, the Spirit of wisdom enables us to *know God* and be with Him in an *intimate way*.

Definition of the Spirit of Revelation – Understanding

‘Revelation’ is the ability to understand that is put into our spirits by the Holy Spirit and then it is sent to our mind (soul).

It is

- the voice of God speaking to our spirits and telling the mind what God is going to do
- the revealing of hidden secrets and mysteries by the Holy Spirit
- seeing clearly into the future

‘Understanding’ is the ability to find out how to do things in-order to get the result.

Conclusion:

The **Spirit of Wisdom** helps us to know the **things of God and God Himself**.

The **Spirit of Revelation** helps us to understand **the knowledge** and **how to apply** it practically.

❖ Manifestations – It's operations

The Spirit of Wisdom and Revelation operates in three ways.

- 1) Knowledge of Godhead
- 2) Eyes of understanding Enlightened
- 3) Revelation of the Riches of the Glory of God.

Let's see each one of them in detail.



1. Knowledge of Godhead



No one has ever seen God the Father. So our knowledge about Him is very limited. This Spirit brings us a revelation and understanding of the knowledge about God.

- a. To understand the meaning of the acts of God
- b. Secrets of Christ's Divinity
- c. Mystery and Purpose of God
- d. Knowing the Father God Intimately



2. Eyes of Understanding Enlightened

When the Spirit of Wisdom and Revelation rests upon you, your spiritual eyes will be opened permanently.

Three things can happen when your spiritual eyes are opened.

- a. You will see the Lord Jesus Christ
- b. You will see – know the thoughts of people
- c. Revelation of Father God



3.Revelation of the Riches of the Glory of God

When the Spirit of Wisdom and Revelation rests upon you, your spiritual eyes will be opened permanently.

Three things can happen when your spiritual eyes are opened.

a. Things that are in heaven



b. The deep Hidden riches and the Secrets of God



❖ Mechanics of Operation

The Spirit of wisdom and Revelation will operate through plenty of ***visions*** and ***revelations*** from the Holy Spirit.



Examples:

1. Joseph (Gen 40:8, 41:38) – He had abundance of dreams and revelations
2. Daniel (Dan 1:17, 5: 11 – 12) – He was given knowledge and skill in all learning and wisdom. He also had the understanding of visions and dreams.
3. Paul – He was also given many visions.

We can see two things here

- They were all filled with the Spirit of Wisdom and Revelation

- This Spirit always operated through visions, dreams and revelations.

Visions and revelations will become your second nature.

❖ Keys to Flow

We may receive many things. But we can and will lose them if we don't maintain them. So there are five ways to receive and maintain the Spirit of Wisdom and Revelation, they are :



1. Be pure, clean and holy



Daniel 1: 8

Prophet Daniel when he was very young at the age of 17 purposed in his heart that he will not defile himself with the king's food. The king's food indicates the worldly things. He kept his body pure, clean and holy for this gift to come and reside in him.



2. Delight in God

Proverbs 8: 30 – 31

Always delight yourself in the Lord in praising and worshiping Him in spirit, truth and in the beauties of holiness.



3. Be humble like a little child

Luke 10: 21

The secret to possess this Spirit and to know the deep things of God is to humble ourselves like small children.

We must never allow pride to creep into our hearts. Be always willing to learn new things like a small child.



4. Meditate God's word

Joshua 1 : 8

The Bible says that God's word is pure (Ps 19 : 8). So, when you meditate God's word you become pure to see the Lord Jesus (Mat 5 : 8).



First meditate and then practice the word of God.

The more you obey and practice the word of God, the more you will become like Him (Jesus).

5. Waiting on God

What does it mean to wait on God?

First make your heart, mind and flesh become quiet and still. Only when you are quiet you can hear the voice of God. If you keep talking all the time then how will you hear the voice of God?

When the heart, mind and flesh becomes quiet, then we can hear the voice of God. Once you have learnt to wait on God then you can hear the voice of the Holy Spirit, the Lord Jesus and the Father God.



One Final Word

The Spirit of Wisdom and Revelation is a precious and wonderful gift. So earnestly desire it!

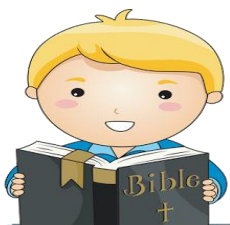

LESSION-3

3. THE SPIRIT OF COUNSEL AND MIGHT

Isaiah 11:2

2 “And the Spirit of the Lord shall rest upon Him, the Spirit of wisdom and understanding, the Spirit of counsel and might, the Spirit of knowledge and the fear of the Lord.”

Here we read about the the Spirit of counsel and might.

Meaning

What is the Spirit of Counsel?

From Proverb 21: 30 and Jeremiah 23: 18 we see that -



The Spirit of Counsel is the Counsel of God.

Definition of Spirit of Counsel:

The Spirit of Counsel can be defined as the advice that the Holy Spirit counsels which determines a plan.

So the Spirit of counsel gives advices, which comes along with the action.

Definition of the Spirit of Might:

The Spirit of Might is the marvelous acts of the Holy Spirit which shows the mighty power of God.

So we can define them together as –

The Spirit of Counsel and Might is the working of the Holy Spirit by giving advices. It gives a plan that will show the mighty works of God's power.

Scriptural Examples:

The Bible records many examples where we can see the Spirit of Counsel and Might in operation.

We will just take one scriptural example and examine its working here.

Case study:

Let's see how the prophet Elijah pulled down fire from heaven. Do you think that he did it by his own power and will? Come let's examine.

In I kings 18: 20 – 40, the prophet Elijah challenges the king Ahab to prove that the Lord is God.

He built an altar with twelve stone. He made a trench about the altar. He put the wood in order and cut a bullock in pieces and laid on the wood. He filled four barrels with water and poured it on the burnt sacrifice and on the wood. He did poured four barrels of water 3 times on the altar and on the wood. Water ran round the altar and completely soaked it. He also filled water in the trench.

Then the prophet Elijah prayed to God saying, “Lord God of Abraham, Isaac and Israel let it be known this day that You are God in Israel and I am Your servant, and that *I have done all these things at Your word. (I kings 18: 36)*

From the prophet’s prayer we can find out that it was the Spirit of Counsel who advised him on how to prepare the altar.

This was an impossible situation.



When everything is drenched and soaked in water even if you bring the biggest oxygen tank with acetylene (gas used for burning) it can never light up the fire. Even in that impossible situation God performed a miracle when His words were obeyed. The fire of God came down and consumed the sacrifice.

If you obey then the Spirit of Might will be manifested to work out the miracle.

Its Manifestations (Its operations)

For us to flow in this Spirit we must know how they will operate. The Spirit of Counsel and Might will operate in three ways. They are

- 1.Through Angels
- 2.Through the Holy Spirit
- 3.Through the Lord Jesus



1. *Through Angels*

The Angels are the transporters of this anointing. They will come to work with this Spirit.

Example: Joshua 6: 1- 20

Joshua got the counsel from an angel to go around Jericho seven times. When Joshua and the Israelites obeyed to the counsel the Spirit of Might did the great act of pulling down the walls of Jericho.

When the counsel of the Spirit of Counsel was obeyed the Spirit of Might worked by bringing down a great wall. This clearly shows that the angels were at work to make the miracle happen.



2. *Through the Holy Spirit*

Example : Acts 8: 20 – 40

The Holy Spirit counseled Philip to go to a place in the desert in Gaza. There he preached the gospel to an Ethiopian official. From there he was then carried by the Holy Spirit to Azotus which is 34 miles away.

3. *Through the Lord Jesus*

Sometimes the Lord Jesus Himself will come personally to make the Spirit of Counsel and Might work.

Example: Acts 23: 11 and 2 Timothy 4: 17

We see here that when Paul was alone without any help the Lord Jesus came to him and told him that he will not die until he testifies about the Lord Jesus in Rome. Paul believed these words. This faith gave him the strength to tear the lions apart like Samson when he was put in an amphitheater.



Mechanics of operation

When the Spirit of Counsel and Might flows as one a big burst of the power of God will happen. And mighty signs and wonders equal to biblical standards (and also more than that) can and will take place.

The big power of God is displayed in 3 ways:

1. Dunamis power
2. Kratos power
3. Ischus power



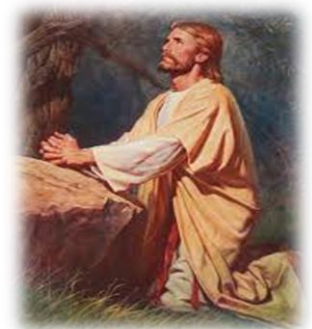
Keys to Flow

How we can activate and flow in this Spirit of Counsel and Might?

In Luke 5: 16, 17 we read

“He Himself often withdrew into the wilderness and prayed..... And the power of the Lord was present to heal them.”

Before the power of the Lord could be present the Lord Jesus spent time in prayer. He prayed in a place where nobody could disturb or interrupt Him.



So there is the *key- Being alone with God.*

The more you spend time in the presence of the Lord the more you are being soaked in His presence.



One Final word

Always be instant to obey what the Spirit of Counsel advises you to do. As you set your heart to do according to that Counsel, the Spirit of Might will do a mighty work.

Lesson-4

4. THE SPIRIT OF KNOWLEDGE AND THE FEAR OF GOD

Isaiah 11:2

2 “And the Spirit of the Lord shall rest upon Him, the Spirit of wisdom and understanding, the Spirit of counsel and might, the Spirit of knowledge and the fear of the Lord.”

Here we read about the Spirit of knowledge and the fear of the Lord.

The Spirit of Knowledge will help you on your journey in knowing about God and the existence of things or events in the past and present. That

knowledge leads us step by step into a very close relationship with – the Most High God.



Definition: The Spirit of Knowledge

The Spirit of Knowledge gives the instructions for understanding God and also to discern men's hearts.

It works in two ways: Firstly it gives the knowledge of God and secondly it gives the knowledge of men.

Definition: The Spirit of the Fear of the Lord

The Spirit of Fear of the Lord is the working of the Holy Spirit that produces a holy fear of God.

When the Bible used the word “fear” in relation to God, it is not a negative fear, but a healthy one which will always bring about a *holy fear*.

It is the fear of the Lord that causes us not to sin. The reason people sin is because they don't fear God.

The “reverential fear” is the fear of God that is combined with love. Because when you love God you also fear God.

So putting both together we can define the **Spirit of Knowledge and the Fear of the Lord** as:

The Holy Spirit gives us an understanding of God and also help us to discern the hearts of men. It also gives us the fear of God.

Explanation:

The Spirit of Knowledge and the Fear of the Lord

- ❖ **Will open your spiritual eyes** and the eyes of your understanding to look into God and to know God. It brings a fear of God in you



- ❖ It allows you to **see into the hearts of man**, revealing the secrets of their heart. It produces a reverential fear of God in the hearts of those who hear the secrets of their heart being openly declared.



Examples:

1. Acts 5: 1- 11

Ananias and Sapphira decided to give a large offering to their church. So they sold one of their properties and kept some for themselves and brought the rest to Peter and said, “This is all the money that we received from selling our possession.”

When the Apostle Peter was about to receive it, the Spirit of Knowledge opened his eyes and he said, “How dare you lie to the Holy Spirit?”

When the Spirit of Knowledge and the Fear of the Lord worked, it showed the secrets of the heart and brought immediate judgment. Both Ananias and his wife dropped dead one after the other.



2. Isaiah 6: 1- 5

The Spirit of Knowledge revealed to the prophet Isaiah the true glory and the majesty of God. As soon as he saw it he dropped down on his knees and cried out “Oh God, I’m an unclean person.”



When the Spirit of Knowledge operates the Spirit of the Fear of the Lord also worked with it to show even the smallest impurities in a person’s life to be brought to light.

Manifestations

1. Speaking in tongues brings the knowledge of God

Acts 2: 11

We hear them speaking in our own tongues the wonderful works of God.



The Disciples spoke in tongues which brought the knowledge of the wondrous works of God to the gentiles. The gentiles otherwise did not know the goodness of the true and living God.

When you speak about the wondrous things of God and magnify God, you are praising God as a result of the knowledge which you have received.

2. Gift of prophesy and tongues together

I Corinthians 14: 22 – 25

In this Scripture portion we can see the working of the Spirit of Knowledge and the Fear of the Lord through prophesy, tongues and interpretation.

When the church is prophesying and giving a message in tongues and when a new comer enters the church, the secrets of their hearts are exposed and the fear of God comes.

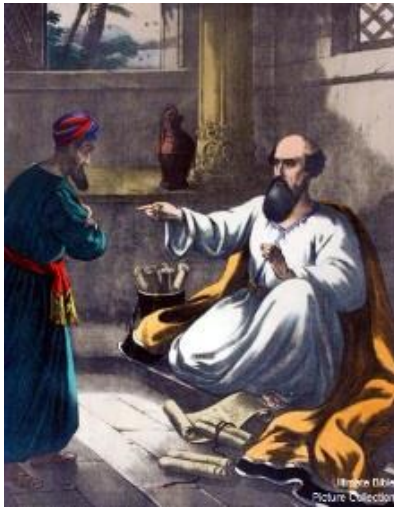


It is the Spirit of Knowledge that shows the secrets of a person's heart. And the Spirit of the Fear of the Lord makes them to fall on their faces and repent.

3. Showing the hearts of men

II Kings 5: 1 – 27

In this incident, Naaman was healed of leprosy. So he wanted to bless the prophet Elisha with an offering. But Elisha refused the gifts. But His servant Gehazi was very greedy and he wanted those gifts. So went behind Naaman

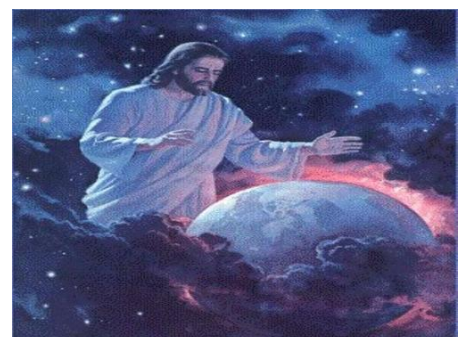


and met him on his way and said that his master had asked him to take some gifts from him because he wanted to bless some other prophets. Naaman was very happy on hearing this. So he gave the gifts to Gehazi.

Gehazi collected the gifts and instead of bringing them to Elisha he hid them in his house. Then he came to wait on his master. When Elisha asked him, "Gehazi, where have you been?" Gehazi lied to him saying, "I didn't go anywhere. I was just waiting outside the door for your command."

Then Elisha said, "Why are you lying? My spirit witnessed every evil deed you did."

Elisha's soul was taken from his body and he saw what Gehazi did.



So be careful, don't think that nobody is watching you when you are committing a sin. You don't know who may be standing there.

4. Speaking judgments

Ezekiel 11: 1 – 13

In this Scripture portion we can see the working of the Spirit of Knowledge and the Fear of the Lord pronouncing judgment.

This Spirit rested upon prophet Ezekiel and he was carried to the temple to see the evil deeds committed there by some of the princes of Israel.

Then the Spirit of the Fear of the Lord manifested bringing about the judgment of death upon the chief of evildoers. Pelatiah dropped down dead.

Oh, it's so exciting to know that the Spirit of Knowledge will expose the hearts of people to us. But at the same time it's so frightening to know that it will bring terrible judgment upon us.

Did Jesus have this Spirit in Him?

Yes of course, Jesus had all the seven Spirits of the Lord in Him.

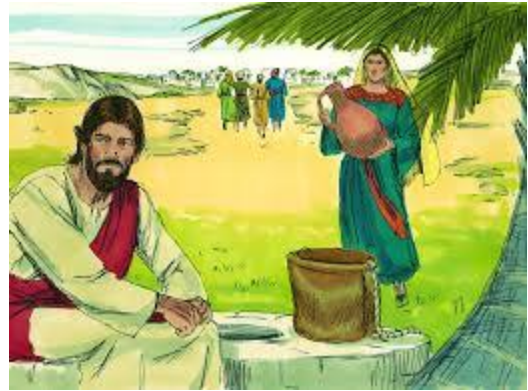


Looking unto Jesus

John 4: 7 – 30

Here we can see the Spirit of Knowledge and the Fear of the Lord exposed the sin in the Samaritan woman's life.

The Spirit of the fear of the Lord brought a deep conviction in her and led her to repentance.



The Mechanics of operation



The Spirit of knowledge and the Fear of the Lord can operate in our lives through various ways: They are

1. Through Angels
2. Through Jesus



1. Through Angel

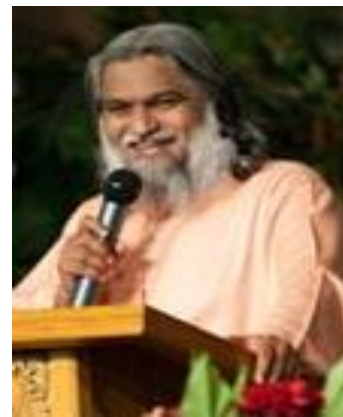
It could be best explained with a beautiful example.

Once when prophet Sadhu Sundar Selvaraj was preaching in a church in Los Angeles, the Lord spoke to him and said, "My temple is defiled." The Lord also gave him a message to be preached. At the time of worship a fiery angel appeared before him and said that no humor should be added to the message. The angel also said that he would release the Spirit of the Fear of the Lord over the church.

When the advice was followed the Spirit of the Fear of the Lord moved over the church and convicted everyone there of their sins. The entire church rededicated their lives to live a holy life thereafter.

1. Through Jesus

In the year 1996, prophet Sadhu Sundar Selvaraj was invited to speak in a Chinese Prayer Conference in Jerusalem. In that conference one lady was very enthusiastic and was very active during the praise and worship. When the time come to deliver the message and when uncle Sadhu offered the initial prayer before the message. At that time the Lord Jesus appeared before him and went straight to that particular lady and took out her spiritual heart and showed it to uncle Sadhu. It was very black with five sins written on it. The Lord then told uncle Sadhu to tell this to that lady. When she heard all her secret sins being exposed, she broke down and repented of her sins.



The Spirit of the Fear of the Lord brought a holy fear and repentance.

Keys to Flow

1. Be full of the word of God

The word of God is the knowledge of God.



2. Walk in the fear of God

The knowledge and understanding of the Holy One will enable you to walk in the fear of God.



3. Guard secrets

Revelations are given not to share but to pray for the concerned person. Intercede for them before the throne of God.



4. Pray in tongues

When you pray in tongues your inner man is built up and it becomes sensitive to the Holy Spirit.



A spiritual information highway is created between you and God, and information flows up and down.

Lesson-5

5. THE SPIRIT OF THE LORD

Isaiah 11: 2

And the Spirit of the Lord shall rest upon Him, the Spirit of wisdom and understanding, the Spirit of counsel and might, the Spirit of Knowledge and of the fear of the lord.

Who is the Spirit of the Lord?



The Spirit of the Lord is the first of the seven Spirits mentioned in Isaiah 11:2.

The Spirit of the Lord releases all the anointing degree by degree.

So what is the difference between Spirit of the Lord and the Holy Spirit?

You all are very familiar with the Holy Spirit. So let me explain about the Spirit of the Lord.

The word “spirit” in Hebrew is *ruwah* which means *a violent blast of the breath of God*.



The Greek word for “spirit” is *pneuma* which means breathe. Breath in Greek means *a blast of breath*.

So if we put both the Hebrew and Greek meanings together it is “blast of breath” meaning a violent exhalation or a blast.

Do you know what really happened when the Red Sea parted?

Exodus 15: 8

And with the Blast of Your nostrils, the floods stood upright like a heap”.

It means the Spirit of the Lord came like the strong east wind and blew upon the sea parting it into two.

1. The manifest (strong) Presence

The presence of God is the gentle presence of God. But when the very strong presence of God comes, we will be down on our faces before God. The very strong presence is like a thick cloud that comes down and rests heavily.

So the Spirit of the Lord is the manifest (very strong) Presence of the Holy Spirit Himself.

Let us turn our attention to Exodus 33: 19 – 2

1) When the Lord said to Moses, “My presence will go before you.”

- Here the Lord was just referring to His anointing.

2) When the Lord came down on Mount Sinai, Moses saw the very strong presence of God face to face.

- No longer was God speaking from a cloud to Moses. The cloud departed and the Lord spoke directly to Moses and he saw the God of Israel.



*The workings of the **Seven Spirits of the Lord** are the (very strong) presence of the **Holy Spirit Himself**.*

When we speak of the Holy Spirit, you will imagine Him only in the Spirit form. You will think that He has no form. But do you know that He can manifest Himself in seven forms?

2. Seven forms of the Spirit of Lord

The Lord Jesus spoke about the Holy Spirit in John 3: 8

The wind blows where it wishes, and you hear the sound of it, but cannot tell where it comes from and where it goes. So is everyone who is born of the Spirit.

The Lord Jesus compares the Holy Spirit to wind. Wind is found everywhere. But wind cannot be seen because it has no form.

Similarly the Holy Spirit thought He is found everywhere, we cannot see Him. The Holy Spirit is within God, it proceeds from God, and it is of God and is God Himself.

But He too can take on some forms. We will see a few of them now.

i. The Shekinah Cloud of Glory

2 Chronicles 5: 13 – 14

The thick Shekinah cloud of God came down upon Solomon's temple. Every one saw it with their physical eyes and they could not enter the temple because the cloud was very thick.



We will not be sitting on their chairs or even standing up. Everyone will fall down on their faces before the holiness of God.

ii. The Dove

Luke 3: 21 – 22

During the baptism of the Lord Jesus, the Holy Spirit took the form of a dove



iii. The River of Living Water

John 7: 38 – 39

The Holy Spirit is the river of living water that is flowing from the Throne of God. (Rev 22: 1)

iv. The Mighty Wind

Acts 2: 1 – 4

The Holy Spirit came down upon the Apostles like a strong and mighty wind when they were waiting for the Holy Spirit.



v. The Menorah

Revelation 4: 5

The Lampstand (the menorah) in the Tabernacle of Moses represents the Holy Spirit.

vi. The Flood

Isaiah 59: 19

The enemy can come like a flood to destroy you. But he forgot that the Holy Spirit can manifest like a flood of waters and push back all the works of the devil.





vii. The Spirit of Christ

Romans 8: 9

The manifested (very strong) presence of the Spirit of the Lord looks exactly like the Lord Jesus. That is why He is also called the Spirit of Christ.

3. How does the Holy Spirit manifest?

We are going to see some of the works of the Spirit of the Lord. But He is not limited to these alone. Remember the wind will blow where ever it wills.

1. Gives the power to make War.

Judges 11:29 - 33

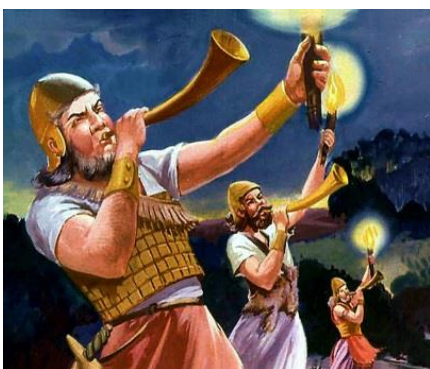
The Spirit of the Lord helped Jephthah to win the Battle where ever he went.



2. Calling forth God's Army

Judges 6: 34, 35

When Gideon blew the trumpet, the Spirit of the Lord within him breathed through the trumpet and gathered an entire army of Israel. This is what will happen in the last days.



3. Gift of Prophecy

I Samuel 23: 1- 3

When David was anointed as king, the Spirit of the Lord came upon him and he too prophesied.



The prophet Samuel had established a school of prophets in Ramah. Whoever came to that place prophesied?

I Samuel 19: 20 – 24) –*the corporate anointing.*

4. Gives the power to do the work of the Lord Jesus

Luke 4: 16 – 19

The Lord Jesus Himself said that whoever believes in Him will do even greater works than what He did.

5. Transformation

II Corinthians 3: 18

When the Spirit of the Lord rests upon us we will be transformed from glory to glory to become like Jesus.

6. Deliverance

Acts 16:25, 26

When the Spirit of the Lord rests upon us the words that we speak will be like a blast from the mouth of God to command deliverance.

When Paul and Silas sang hymns in the jail they received a powerful deliverance.



7. Supernatural Transportations



The Spirit of the Lord can transform you both bodily and in the spirit from one place to another. You can even be transported in the Spirit across time.

- **Enoch** - Genesis 5: 24
- **Elijah** - I Kings 18: 12
- **The Lord Jesus** - John 6: 21
- **Ezekiel** - Ezekiel 8: 3
- **John** - Revelation 4: 1

The most important quality that is required of you is ***abiding in Christ.***



4. Four Levels of Manifestation

The Spirit of the Lord flows like a river.

This river flows at four levels

Ezekiel 47: 3 – 5

- i. water came up to my ankles.
- ii. water came up to my knees
- iii. water came up to my waist
- iv. water in which one must swim

5. Keys to allow the Holy Spirit flow in you

There are three factors that you must have to allow these rivers to flow through you.



1. **Obedience**
2. **Faithfulness**
3. **Meekness and Humility**

One Final word

The more you bow down, the more you humble yourself, the more the anointing will increase in your life. The more you humble yourself, the higher God promotes you.
